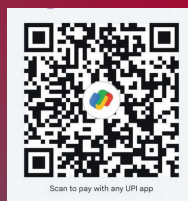
Qualitative research plays a vital role in understanding human experiences, perceptions, beliefs and social contexts that cannot be fully captured through quantitative methods.
